

Economic Impact

Catalyst Campus economic impact is measured through the direct effect of the businesses physically at the Campus, the B to B impact between local businesses and Campus tenants, and the induced impact of all these employees being active consumers and taxpayers in the community.



1,193 jobs were attributable to Catalyst Campus in 2019
